## **Archaeology of Syria**

*Hellenistic and Roman Periods (500 BC – 500 AD)*

The Archaeology of Syria (the Roman province) was the main focus of the academic career of Professor Andreas Schmidt-Colinet, who taught Classical Archaeology at the University of Vienna until recently.

Since 1981, Schmidt-Colinet has been leading the 'Palmyra Project' of the DAI (German Archaeological Institute), a long term cooperation between Germany, Austria and Syria. Over a period of more than 30 years he built this working library which is now up for sale.

While Palmyra naturally features very strongly in the collection, other key locations including Hawran, Doura Europos, Baalbek, Dekapolis and Petra are also well represented.

Besides many excavation reports the collection contains important handbooks and references, 46 volumes of bound articles, reprints and chapters which are arranged thematically, as well as more than 330 offprints. – Many items cannot be obtained anywhere on the market.
